- Presentation of September 22, 2020 Virtual PTA Meeting Minutes for approval (via majority vote)
   motion was seconded and passed via electronic vote (13 in favor/ 0 opposed). Minutes are posted on PTA website.
- Presentation of proposed revised bylaws. Bylaws required to be approved every 5 years.

- Treasurer's Report Given by Ann Marie Ward. Reports are on PTA website. Due to COVID, we
  have fewer activities this year. Have collected dues & donations electronically on PTA website,
  as it's harder to collect cash and checks this year. Are halfway to membership goal (projected

100 members, currently almost to 60). Dues are \$10/person and will be a major source of income this year with less fundraising activities. Donations are tax deductible via website. We will be spending our reserves for the most part this school year.
