### **PTA Officer Election Process:**

*The Glasgow PTA® Executive Board consists of 6 officers:*

*President*

*VP-Organization and Outreach*

*VP-School Activities*

*VP-Communications*

*Treasurer*

*Secretary*

*Officers serve for one term (1 year) and are eligible to serve up to two terms (2 years). Here is the general process by which the 6 officers are selected:*

- 1. A Nominating Committee is formed and presented for approval at the March PTA general membership meeting. Only members of this PTA® present at the meeting may vote.*
- 2. Once approved, the Nominating Committee will begin the search to identify a candidate for each of the 6 positions. Any individual interested in being considered for a position may contact a member of the Nominating Committee to discuss their interest. The Nominating Committee will build a slate of candidates for the 6 positions. Candidates must be current members of this PTA® for the current fiscal year.*
- 3. The Nominating Committee will report its slate of candidates at the April PTA general membership meeting.*
- 4. The slate of candidates is presented for approval at the May PTA general membership meeting. At this general membership meeting, additional nominations may be made from the floor. Only members of this PTA® present at the meeting may vote.*
